






## The current landscape PISA 2018 tested 14,000 Australian students. Percentage of illiterate 15-year-olds had grown to almost 20%. Around 40% were unable to read at a 'proficient standard'. Nearly 1 in 5 Australian students start secondary school at or below minimum standards for literacy. Bridging the Literacy Gap **Some Australian Studies** Few secondary schools are consistently providing students with support they are confident will make a difference. A third of school staff said they found it difficult to identify students who are struggling. **Some Australian Studies** Some teachers also lack confidence about which foundational skills to prioritise and how to organise support in secondary education. One concern was that interventions are often aimed at providing access to curriculum material at the current year level, rather than developing missing foundational skills.
